RE: Compliance Bond

All amateur boxing clubs and amateur mixed martial arts clubs shall place on file with this office a compliance bond in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) before licenses or bout permits will be issued. All professional boxing, wrestling, and mixed martial arts clubs shall place on file with this office a compliance bond in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5000.00) before licenses or bout permits will be issued. A fully executed bond following the "sample guide" provided by this office must accompany each application for a license. All bonds and licenses shall expire simultaneously on the 30th of June each year.

The corporate surety company must be authorized to do business in the State of Nebraska.

An attorney-in-fact or officer of the surety company must execute the bond and must attach a power-of-attorney or other evidence of authority to sign. The corporate seal of the surety must be pressed on or attached to the bond.

If the bond principal (applicant for license) is a corporation, the officer of the corporation must sign. If a partnership, one of the partners must sign, and if an individual, that individual must sign. No exceptions.
